<b>Western Blot</b>	Preliminary experiments in Human Brain (Hippocampus, Olfactory bulb) lysates gave no specific signal but low background (at antibody concentration up to 1µg/ml). We would appreciate any feedback from people in the field - have any results been reported with other antibodies/lysates?
