Purification and Storage

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

Applications Tested

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:8000.

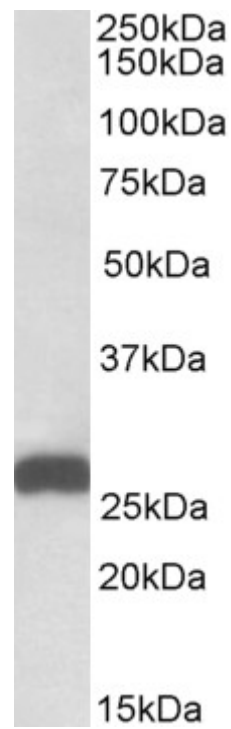
Western blot: Approx 26kDa band observed in Human, Mouse and Rat Liver lysates (calculated MW of 27.8kDa according to NP_001976.1). Recommended concentration: 0.01-0.03µg/ml.

IHC: In paraffin embedded Human Liver shows mitochondrial staining in hepatocytes. Recommended concentration, 3-5µg/ml.

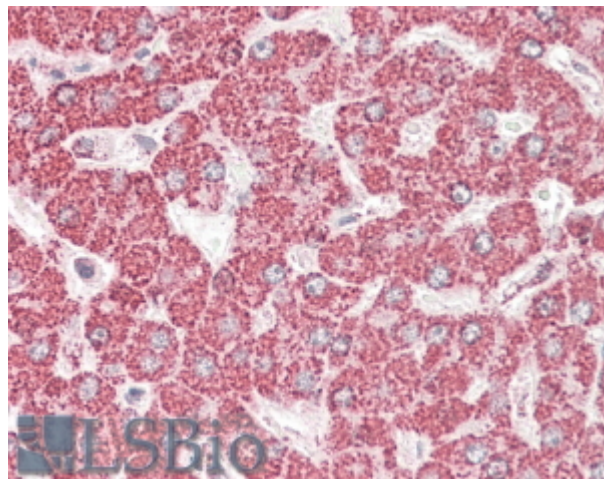
