### **Immunogen**

Peptide with sequence C-PQRTAGVKVETTE, from the C Terminus of the protein sequence according to NP\_001976.1; NP\_001014763.1.

Please note the peptide is available for sale.

## **Purification and Storage**

Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in Tris saline, 0.02% sodium azide, pH7.3 with 0.5% bovine serum albumin.

Aliquot and store at -20°C. Minimize freezing and thawing.

#### **Applications Tested**

Peptide ELISA: antibody detection limit dilution 1:8000.


**Western blot:** Approx 26kDa band observed in Human, Mouse and Rat Liver lysates (calculated MW of 27.8kDa according to NP\_001976.1). Recommended concentration: 0.01-0.03µg/ml.

**IHC:** In paraffin embedded Human Liver shows mitochondrial staining in hepatocytes. Recommended concentration, 3-5µg/ml.


# **Species Reactivity**

Tested: Human, Mouse, Rat

Expected from sequence similarity: Human, Mouse, Rat, Dog, Cow



EB10172 (0.01 $\mu$ g/ml) staining of Mouse Liver lysate (35 $\mu$ g protein in RIPA buffer). Primary incubation was 1 hour. Detected by chemiluminescence.



EB10172 (3.8µg/ml) staining of paraffin embedded Human Liver. Steamed antigen retrieval with citrate buffer pH 6, AP-staining.
